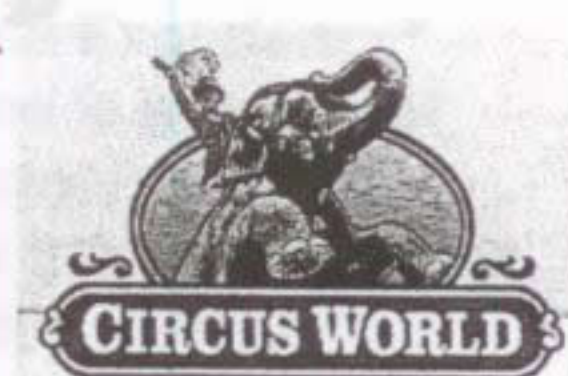

MACKINAC ISLAND & WISCONSIN

Featuring the Upper Peninsula, Wisconsin Dells, & House on the Rock!

6 Days - 5 Nights

The sample itinerary described below is like the one your group will follow during your tour. The exact sequence of days and daily activities may vary on your final itinerary.

Day 1 – Depart from your hometown and travel to St. Ignace where you will check into your hotel and freshen up for a delicious dinner.

Day 2 – Depart on the early **high-speed ferry** across the Straits to quaint Mackinac Island. Upon arrival, board a horse-drawn taxi that will transport you up the hill to the magnificent **Grand Hotel** where a delicious breakfast awaits in the spacious dining room. You'll have time after breakfast for a self-guided tour of the common area of the hotel and the opportunity to rock on the porch overlooking the manicured gardens. Board a **horse-drawn carriage for a narrated tour of the island** with several stops along the way at scenic overlooks. Lunch is on your own after the tour at one of the restaurants in the village, with time to browse the shops and sample some fudge before returning via the high-speed ferry to the mainland. Return to your lodging to prepare for a delicious barbecue dinner, followed by an optional visit to the **Kewadin Shores Casino** where you can try your luck at the games of your choice.

Day 3 – Enjoy breakfast, then check out and travel through the Upper Peninsula en route to the Wisconsin Dells. Upon arrival you will check into your hotel and enjoy a delicious dinner in the area.

Day 4 – Following breakfast, depart for a visit to the **House on the Rock** for the “**Ultimate Experience**” – admission to all three tours! From awe-inspiring to mystifying, The House is home to a myriad of fascinating exhibits including whimsical carousels, enormous sea creatures, fascinating music machines and so much more. Visit a **Wisconsin Cheese Factory** and learn the process of making cheese - taste a sample! A giant wooden lumberjack proudly welcomes your group to **Paul Bunyan's Restaurant** this evening for a delicious dinner with a local flavor.

Day 5 – Arise to breakfast at the inn, then depart for a **Wisconsin Ducks** (an original World War II vehicle) **land and water tour** which covers seven miles of the Wisconsin River and Lake Delton. Lunch is on your own before boarding a **horse-drawn wagon for a tour of the Lost Canyon**. You'll see sandstone formations with walls reaching as high as 80 feet! Dinner tonight is at the **Thunder Valley Inn** – a scrumptious homemade meal, topped off with food for your soul – fiddling, sing-a-long, accordion playing, and uff da fun jokes and stories!

Day 6 – Breakfast at the inn, then check out and depart for a morning visit to the **Circus World Museum**. The museum recreates the history of the Ringling Brothers Circus. See the world's largest collection of antique circus parade wagons, all intricately hand-carved, glittering works of art. Depart for home after your visit, taking with you wonderful memories of your vacation in beautiful Wisconsin.
